Objective Statement

The Earthquakes and Megacities Initiative (EMI) and the Governorate of Jakarta in partnership with Indonesia Institute of Technology, Bandung, ProVention Consortium, Pacific Disaster Center, the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP/BCPR), and the United Nations International Strategy for Disaster Reduction (UN-ISDR), are organizing the **Asia Megacities Forum 2007 in Jakarta, Indonesia on 24-26 October 2007**. The Forum is a contribution to the local implementation of the Hyogo Framework for Action. The first day of the Forum will be held jointly with the participants of the Asia Network of Major Cities, which is having its congress in Jakarta from 22-24 October.

A number of local authorities and local government institutions are committed and engaged in the implementing disaster risk reduction in their cities and communities. The objective of EMI's Cluster Cities Project (CCP) is to build a coalition of informed leaders, promote peer-to-peer knowledge sharing, and support the implementation of sound DRR practices at the local level. The 2007 Asia Megacities Forum is undertaken to support that objective.

The **Asia Megacities Forum 2007** will gather the members of EMI's Cluster Cities Project-Asia Clusters, partnering scientific and academic institutions, invited local government organizations, and a broad representation from international and regional organizations. The Forum builds on the accomplishments of the 2006 Asia Megacities Forum (Kobe, November 2006), and will serve as a platform to demonstrate knowledge of sound practices in DRR that other cities may validate, adapt, and apply to their own risk context. It aims to facilitate peer-to-peer learning exchange and empowerment among cities in building capabilities to implement DRR sound practices in their cities and communities. The Forum also seeks to serve as a knowledge dissemination platform and a coalition building mechanism in favor of the local implementation of the principles and actions of the Hyogo Framework for Action.
